SMALL GROUP FACILITATED DISCUSSIONS

08-09 December 2020

The discussions and presentations from today's meeting were intended to provide a starting point for further debate, to involve all the stakeholders in the questions raised.

Let's take as our starting point the following propositions:

- The mandates, roles and structures of financial institutions are changing fast
- We are tackling multiple simultaneous global challenges at present
- There is next to no coordination between stakeholders and across silos

Now we want to hear your views! How do you see the landscape changing, and what do you think should be the priorities for joined up action across the 'marketplace' in order to tackle the various challenges we are facing, collectively?

1. Context and introductions

- What has been your institutions' experiences in the face of COVID? What changes do you expect to see carried forwards?

2. Complementarity of risk profiles

- Is there sometimes a tension (or difficult reconciliation) between your official mandate and the challenges which have emerged during the seminar?

3. How do we prioritise?

- Which are the top 3-priorities to be addressed by our institutions in these challenging times? Can we simultaneously tackle both the COVID credit challenge *and* climate issues at the same time?

4. Joined up action

- What practical steps could help to improve the level of coordination between different stakeholders? What can we do through a platform like the CSM?
